Upon successful completion: Staff will learn how to set up and understand proper surgical protocol and sterile technique. The Doctor will spend one-half day discussing proper diagnosis and treatment planning of 3-5 personal patient cases; thus learning how to stay out of trouble placing implants. Both Doctor/Staff will learn proper sterile gowning and gloving as well as proper documentation of patient records. Implants will be placed in artificial mandibles. Staff will learn how to talk with patients about dental implant treatment. Doctor/staff will learn proper suturing so sutures remained tied for two weeks. Doctor/staff will learn proper photography. Staff will learn prosthetic components so they can help serve doctor and patient and be ready to participate in the. . .
